11 An Act relating to special license plates; amending
12 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by
13 Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
14 2020, Section 1135.2), which relates to special
15 license plates; creating the Veterans of the United
16 States Armed Forces License Plate; providing for
17 design of the plate; excluding certain dishonorably
18 discharged members; requiring certain initial
19 verification of eligibility; creating the Navy Chief
20 License Plate; providing for design of the plate;
21 limiting issue of the plate to certain individuals;
22 requiring certain initial verification; allowing
23 application for certain vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
24 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 3,
Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section
1135.5), which relates to special license plates;
allowing licensing fee to be paid to certain
organization for the Veterans of Foreign Wars License
Plate; updating statutory reference; creating the
Guthrie Street Kings License Plate; providing for
design of the plate; authorizing entry into licensing
agreement; providing maximum licensing fee payment;
creating the Epilepsy Foundation License Plate;
providing for design of the plate; authorizing entry
into licensing agreement; providing maximum licensing
fee payment; creating the American First License
Plate; providing for design of the plate; authorizing
entry into licensing agreement; providing maximum

1 licensing fee payment; and providing an effective
2 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
6 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
7 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

8 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
9 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
10 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
11 provided by this section.

12 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
13 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
14 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
15 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
16 registered for the current year.

17 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
18 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
19 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
20 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
21 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
22 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
23 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
24 amateur radio operator license plates.

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
14 follows:

15 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
17 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
18 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
19 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
20 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
21 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
22 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
23 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
24 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war

1 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
3 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
4 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
5 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

6 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
8 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
9 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
10 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

11 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
13 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
14 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
15 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
17 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
18 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
19 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
20 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
21 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
22 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
23 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
24 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or

1 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
2 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
3 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
4 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
6 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
7 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
8 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
10 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

11 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
13 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
14 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
16 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
17 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
18 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
19 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
20 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
21 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
22 of one (1) ton or less;

23 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper

1 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
2 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
3 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
4 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
5 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
6 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
7 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
8 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
9 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
10 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
11 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
12 provided by this section for special license plates;

13 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
15 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
16 the United States as being:

- 17 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
18 7, 1941,
- 19 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
20 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
21 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
22 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 23 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
24 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
3 less;

4 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
7 States as being:

- 8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
9 of 1945,
- 10 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
11 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
17 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
20 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
21 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
22 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
23 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
24 registration after the initial issue;

1 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
4 the United States as being:

5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
6 1944,

7 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
8 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
9 participation cannot be verified by the United States
10 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
11 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
12 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
13 the person applying for the license plate, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
20 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
21 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
24 was killed in action and that the person making the application is

1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
5 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
10 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
11 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
12 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
13 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
14 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
15 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
22 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
23 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
24 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a

1 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
6 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
10 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
11 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
12 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
13 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
14 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
16 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
17 education police department by either an identification card or
18 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
19 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
20 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
21 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
22 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
24 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design

1 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
2 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

3 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
9 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
10 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
11 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
16 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
17 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
18 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
19 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
20 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
21 "WORLD WAR II";

22 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
4 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
5 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
6 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
11 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
12 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
13 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
14 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
15 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

16 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
18 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
19 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
20 be produced upon application;

21 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
23 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
24 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a

1 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
2 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
3 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
4 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
5 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
6 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
7 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
8 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
9 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
10 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

11 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
12 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
13 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
14 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
15 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
16 of one (1) ton or less;

17 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
19 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
20 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
21 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
23 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
24

1 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
2 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

3 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
5 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
6 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
7 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
8 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

9 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
10 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
11 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
12 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
13 the Ninety-Nines;

14 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
16 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
17 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
18 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
19 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
20 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
21 less;

22 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
24 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United

1 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
2 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

4 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
6 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
7 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
8 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

9 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
11 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
12 United States Secretary of Defense;

13 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
16 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
17 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
18 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
21 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
22 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
23 district number;

24

1 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
3 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
4 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
5 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
6 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
7 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
8 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
9 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
10 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
11 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
12 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
13 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
14 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
15 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
16 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
17 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
18 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
19 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
21 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
22 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
23 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees

24

1 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
2 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

3 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
4 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
5 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
6 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
7 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
8 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
9 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
10 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
11 the Tax Commission;

12 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
14 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
15 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Association;

17 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
19 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
20 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
21 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
22 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
23 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
24 Academy;

1 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
3 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
4 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
5 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
6 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
7 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
8 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
9 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
10 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
11 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
12 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
13 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
14 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
15 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
16 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
17 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
18 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
19 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
20 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
21 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
22 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
23 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
24 right to such special identification plates herein provided for

1 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
2 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

3 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
5 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
7 Oklahoma;

8 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
10 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
11 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
12 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
13 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
14 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
15 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
16 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
17 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
18 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
19 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
20 state;

21 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
22 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
23 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
24 shall mean:

- 1 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
2 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
3 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
4 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
5 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
6 while on active military duty, or
- 7 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
8 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
9 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
10 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
11 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
12 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
13 discharge of such person.

14 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
15 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
16 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
17 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

18 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
20 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
21 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
22 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1 39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
3 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
4 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
5 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
6 Infantry;

7 40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
9 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
10 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
11 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;
13 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
14 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
15 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

16 41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
18 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
19 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
20 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
21 (1) ton or less;

22 42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
24 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in

1 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
2 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
3 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
4 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
5 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a
6 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of
7 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a
8 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
9 license plate;

10 43. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
11 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
12 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
13 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
14 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
15 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
16 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
17 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 44. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
21 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
22 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
23 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
24 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.

1 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
2 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
3 (1) ton or less;

4 45. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
6 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
7 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
8 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
9 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
10 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
11 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

13 46. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
14 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
15 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
16 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
17 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
18 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

19 47. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
20 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
21 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
22 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
23 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
24 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

1 48. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
3 who present proper certification from the United States Department
4 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
5 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
6 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United
10 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
11 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
12 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate
13 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
14 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
15 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

16 50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
17 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
18 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
19 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
20 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
21 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
22 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
23 Department of the State of Oklahoma;

24

1 51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who
3 present proper certification from the United States Army. The
4 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the
5 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge
6 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
8 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
9 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
10 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

11 52. Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
13 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi
14 Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license
15 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
16 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for
17 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
18 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements
19 for a motorcycle license plate;

20 53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
22 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation
23 Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat
24 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
2 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
3 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
4 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; and

5 54. Special Forces Association - such plates shall be designed
6 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the Army
7 Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear upon the person's
8 United States military uniform the Army Special Forces Tab. Persons
9 applying for the Special Forces Association license plate must
10 provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special Forces Tab or
11 authorizing its wear upon a United States military uniform. The
12 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Special
13 Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. The Tax Commission shall produce
14 up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces Association
15 license plate. Qualified persons may select one design at the time
16 of application. The plates shall be issued to any qualified person
17 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
18 seven, as for personalized license plates;

19 55. Veterans of the United States Armed Forces - such plates
20 shall be designed for veterans of the United States Armed Forces,
21 and shall identify which branch of service, carry the emblem and
22 name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard,
23 according to the branch of service to which the member belonged and
24 shall reflect veteran status. Former members who have been

1 dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
2 Initial verification of eligibility of persons applying for such a
3 license plate shall be accomplished through confirmation of
4 registration in the Oklahoma Veterans Registry, as established in
5 Section 421 of Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and confirmation
6 of eligibility by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.
7 Annual verification of eligibility thereafter shall not be required;
8 and

9 56. Navy Chief License Plate - such plates shall be designed
10 and issued to any resident of this state that has achieved the rank
11 of E7 through E9 in the United States Navy and was either honorably
12 discharged or is an active or retired member of the United States
13 Navy. Initial verification of eligibility of persons applying for
14 such a license plate shall be accomplished through confirmation of
15 registration in the Oklahoma Veterans Registry, as established in
16 Section 421 of Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and confirmation
17 of eligibility by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs.
18 Annual verification of eligibility thereafter shall not be required.
19 Such persons may apply for a Navy Chief license plate for vehicles
20 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a
21 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of
22 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a
23 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
24 license plate.

1 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
2 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
3 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
4 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
5 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
6 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

7 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
8 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
9 2020, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

10 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
11 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
12 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
13 financial assistance as provided by this section.

14 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
15 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
16 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
17 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
18 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

19 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
20 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
21 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
22 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
23 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
24 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon

1 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
2 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

3 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
4 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
5 applications for special license plates authorized under this
6 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
8 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
12 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
13 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

15 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
16 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
17 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
18 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
19 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
20 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
21 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
22 removed from the vehicle.

23 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
24 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax

1 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
2 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
3 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
4 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
5 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
6 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
7 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

8 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
9 follows:

10 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
13 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
14 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

15 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
19 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
20 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
21 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
23 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
24 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued

1 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
2 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
3 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
4 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
5 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
6 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

7 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
8 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

9 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
10 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
11 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
12 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
13 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
14 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
15 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
16 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
17 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
18 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
19 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
20 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
21 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

23 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &

1 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
2 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

3 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
5 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
7 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
8 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
9 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
10 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
11 plates.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
14 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
18 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
19 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
20 the prevention of child abuse.

21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

23 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
24 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
2 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
3 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
4 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
5 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
6 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
7 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
9 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
10 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
11 issued;

12 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
14 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
15 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
16 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

17 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

18 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
19 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
22 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
23 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
24 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

1 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
3 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
4 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
5 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
6 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
7 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
8 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
9 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
10 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
11 issued;

12 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
14 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
15 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
16 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
17 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
18 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
21 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
22 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
24 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
2 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
3 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
4 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
5 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
8 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
9 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
10 Revolving Fund;

11 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
15 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
16 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
17 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
18 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
19 provide services to crime victims;

20 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
23 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
24 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of

1 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
2 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
3 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

4 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
5 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
6 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
8 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
9 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
10 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
11 Section 1104.4 of this title;

12 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
14 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
16 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
17 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
18 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
19 1104.3 of this title;

20 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
22 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
23 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
24 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
3 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
4 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
7 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
8 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
10 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
11 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
12 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
13 follows:

- 14 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
15 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 16 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
17 Education Revolving Fund,
- 18 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
19 Career Technology Fund, and
- 20 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
21 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
22 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
23 Oklahoma Statutes.

24

1 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
2 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
3 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
4 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
5 paragraph;

6 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
8 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
9 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
10 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
11 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
12 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
13 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
14 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
18 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
19 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
20 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
21 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
22 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
23 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

1 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
4 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
5 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
6 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
7 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
8 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
9 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
10 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
11 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
12 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
15 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
16 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
17 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
18 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
20 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
21 of this title;

22 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
24 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and

1 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
2 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
3 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
4 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
5 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
10 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
11 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
12 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
13 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
14 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
15 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
16 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
17 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
18 created families;

19 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,

13 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
14 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
16 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
17 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
18 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
19 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
20 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
21 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

22 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
24 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person

1 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
2 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
3 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
4 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
5 Section 1104.8 of this title;

6 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
7 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
9 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
10 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
11 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
12 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
13 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
14 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
15 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
16 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
17 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
18 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
19 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
20 plate issued;

21 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
24 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.

1 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
2 agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing
3 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
4 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
5 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
6 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The

15 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
16 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
17 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
18 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma

20 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
22 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
23 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
24 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty

1 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
2 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
3 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
5 Section 1104.10 of this title;

6 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
8 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who

10 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
11 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for

15 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
18 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
19 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
20 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
22 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
23 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
24 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
2 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
4 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
5 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
6 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
7 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
8 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
9 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the

18 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in
20 Section 1104.12 of this title;

21 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
23 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates

1 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
2 letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license
3 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
5 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

6 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
8 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
9 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
10 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
11 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this
12 title;

13 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
14 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
15 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
16 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
20 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

21 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
24 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from

1 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
2 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
3 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
4 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
5 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
6 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
7 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
8 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
9 each license plate issued;

10 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
11 be authorized to be designed and issued to any person wishing to
12 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Chapter of Folds of Honor
13 Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization exempt from
14 taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, 26
15 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing educational scholarships to
16 spouses and children of America's fallen and disabled military
17 service members. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
19 Such person may apply for a Folds of Honor Supporter license plate

13 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
14 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
15 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
16 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
17 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
18 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
19 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
20 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
21 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
22 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
23 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers

12 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
13 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other

16 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
17 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as

20 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
21 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
22 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
23 Registration Act; and

1 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
2 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
