6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; requiring certain schools
8 that administer certain survey to include certain
9 affidavit; providing definition; requiring certain
10 schools that contract with a third party to
11 administer certain survey to include certain
12 affidavit; providing for codification; providing an
13 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-159 of Title 70, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, a school district,
19 public charter school, or virtual charter school that administers
20 any survey shall include as part of the survey an affidavit
21 verifying that administration of the survey and the collection of
22 survey responses complies with the Protection of Pupil Rights
23 Amendment, 20 U.S.C. Section 1232h. For the purposes of this
24 section, "survey" means any questionnaire, data collection, risk
25 assessment, or solicitation of information from students used to

1 assess home environment, political or philosophical ideology,
2 religion, political affiliation, information about families, gender
3 orientation, sexual orientation, safety or risk, drug use, or health
4 including vaccination status. "Survey" does not mean an academic
5 assessment.

6 B. If a school district, public charter school, or virtual
7 charter school contracts with a third party to administer a survey
8 and collect survey responses, the third party shall include the
9 affidavit required by subsection A of this section.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
