6 An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; amending 72  
7 O.S. 2011, Section 48.2, which relates to extension  
8 of professional license during active service;  
9 amending number of days allowed for extension; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2011, Section 48.2, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 48.2. A. As used in this section, "license" means any  
15 license issued pursuant to:

- 16 1. Title 59, Professions and Occupations; and
- 17 2. Title 5, Attorneys and State Bar.

18 B. Any license held by a member of the National Guard or  
19 reserve component of the armed forces that expires while the member  
20 is on active duty shall be extended until ~~ninety (90)~~ one hundred  
21 twenty (120) days after the member is discharged from active duty  
22 status.

23 C. The licensing agency shall renew a license extended pursuant  
24 to subsection B until the next date that the license expires or for

1 the period that the license is normally issued, at no cost to the  
2 member of the National Guard or reserve component of the armed  
3 forces if all of the following conditions are met:

4 1. The National Guard member or reservist requests renewal of  
5 the license within ~~ninety (90)~~ one-hundred twenty (120) days after  
6 being discharged;

7 2. The National Guard member or reservist provides the  
8 licensing agency with a copy of the official orders of the member or  
9 reservist calling the member or reservist to active duty, and  
10 official orders discharging the member or reservist from active  
11 duty; and

12 3. The National Guard member or reservist meets all the  
13 requirements necessary for the renewal of the license, except the  
14 member or reservist need not meet the requirements, if any, that  
15 relate to continuing education or training.

16 D. The provisions of this section do not apply to regularly  
17 scheduled annual training.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.  
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
