3 C. The licensing agency shall renew a license extended pursuant  
4 to subsection B until the next date that the license expires or for  
5 the period that the license is normally issued, at no cost to the  
6 member of the National Guard or reserve component of the armed  
7 forces if all of the following conditions are met:

8 1. The National Guard member or reservist requests renewal of  
9 the license within ~~ninety (90)~~ one-hundred twenty (120) days after  
10 being discharged;

11 2. The National Guard member or reservist provides the  
12 licensing agency with a copy of the official orders of the member or  
13 reservist calling the member or reservist to active duty, and  
14 official orders discharging the member or reservist from active  
15 duty; and

16 3. The National Guard member or reservist meets all the  
17 requirements necessary for the renewal of the license, except the  
18 member or reservist need not meet the requirements, if any, that  
19 relate to continuing education or training.

20 D. The provisions of this section do not apply to regularly  
21 scheduled annual training.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
