14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 5-60.4, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 5-60.4. A. The duties of the director of the Oklahoma
17	Farm to School Program within the Oklahoma Department of
18	Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall include, but not be limited
19	to:
20	1. Identifying and promoting the critical components of
21	individual Farm to School Programs and advising the agencies on
22	needed actions and strategies to implement the Oklahoma Farm to
23	School Program;

2. Establishing a partnership with public and nonprofit sources to implement a public engagement campaign and establish a structure to facilitate communication between farmers and school districts;

- 3. Providing leadership at the state level to encourage school districts to develop and improve school nutrition plans using locally grown farm-fresh products;
- 4. Conducting workshops, training sessions, and technical assistance to school food services directors, personnel, farmers, and produce distributors and processors regarding the demand for and the availability of Oklahoma farm products; and
- 5. Seeking grants from private donations and other funding sources; and
- 6. Establishing a farm to school grant program as provided for in subsection B of this section.
- B. 1. The farm to school grant program established pursuant to paragraph 6 of subsection A of this section shall provide grants to:
 - a. farmers and other producers in this state to increase

 their capacity to produce locally grown farm-fresh

 products for school districts and to establish or

 expand production and distribution infrastructure to

 support the use of locally grown farm-fresh products

 in school districts, and
 - <u>b.</u> <u>school districts to purchase locally grown farm-fresh</u> products for use in school meals.
