15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9c of Title 36, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Subject to the availability of funding, the Oklahoma Insurance
19 Department shall analyze discrepancies between coverage for
20 prescription drugs with abuse-deterrent properties and coverage for
21 prescription opioids without abuse-deterrent properties. Such
22 information shall be submitted in a report to the President Pro
23 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
24 Representatives on or before December 31, 2017.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
