BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.9c of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Subject to the availability of funding, the Oklahoma Insurance Department shall analyze discrepancies between coverage for prescription drugs with abuse-deterrent properties and coverage for prescription opioids without abuse-deterrent properties. Such information shall be submitted in a report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2017.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
