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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
16	A. Effective July 1, 2017, every full-time employee of the
17	Oklahoma Department of Corrections, including temporary and other
18	limited-term employees of the Department, who was employed by the
19	Department on the last working day of June 2017, shall receive an
20	annualized salary increase equal to five percent (5.0%) of the
21	employee's annualized salary as of June 30, 2017.
22	B. As used in this section, "temporary and other limited-term
23	employees" are those employees who:
24	1. Are not permanent employees;

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2. Are not otherwise excluded by this section; and

3. Are compensated by the Department for a limited duration and
 without any subjective expectation by either the employer or the
 employee that the employment will become permanent.

C. Employees eligible for the increase provided for in
subsection A of this section who are on leave without pay on July 1,
2017, shall receive an annualized five percent (5.0%) increase,
effective upon their return to work, but shall not receive the
increase for the period prior to their return to work.

10 D. Employees who leave the Department before July 1, 2017, and who are reinstated or reemployed by the Department during July 2017, 11 12 without a break in service, who are otherwise eligible for the pay 13 increase provided for in this section, shall be granted such raise effective immediately upon such reinstatement or reemployment. 14 As used in this subsection, "break in service" is defined as a period 15 of time in excess of thirty (30) calendar days between two periods 16 17 of state employment.

E. Classified employees eligible for the salary increase provided for in this section shall receive such increase even if it causes the employee's salary to exceed the maximum for the employee's pay band.

22 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be 23 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

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1 No funds appropriated for the purpose of implementing the pay increase provided in Section 1 of this act shall be expended by the 2 3 Department to increase compensation for persons employed by a private business entity that has entered into a contract with the 4 5 Department to provide personnel services or temporary services to the public employing entity in order for the public employing entity 6 to perform duties imposed upon it by law or functions which the 7 public employing entity is authorized to perform by law. 8 The 9 provisions of this section shall not be construed to prohibit 10 increases in compensation to a vendor performing other types of 11 services pursuant to a sole source contract or contract awarded 12 pursuant to The Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. 13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
