7	An Act relating to schools; providing definitions;
8	requiring school district boards of education to adopt certain policy allowing certain students to
9	participate in certain activities; providing eligibility criteria for participation; providing for
10	certain method of evaluation to demonstrate adherence to certain standards; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section
11	27-103, which relates to the Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities Accountability Act; requiring certain
12	association's written policy to include certain provision regarding participation of certain
13	students; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-120 of Title 70, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. As used in this section:
21	1. "Resident district" means the public school district in
22	which a student resides as defined in Section 1-113 of Title 70 of
23	the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 2. "School athletic association" shall have the same meaning as 2 provided for in Section 27-102 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 3 and

3. "Students who are educated by other means" means students
who are educated pursuant to the other means of education exception
provided for in subsection A of Section 10-105 of Title 70 of the
Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Each school district board of education shall adopt a policy
 allowing students who are educated by other means to participate in
 extracurricular activities offered by the student's resident
 district. The policy shall be published in the school district's
 student handbook and posted on the school district's website.

C. In order to participate in extracurricular activities pursuant to the provisions of this section, a student who is educated by other means shall:

16 1. Register an intention to participate with the board of 17 education of the resident district by July 1 immediately preceding 18 the school year in which participation is intended;

Pay any participation or activity fee in an amount equal to any fee charged to a resident district participant;

3. Adhere to the same standards of behavior, responsibility, performance, and code of conduct as other participants of the resident district;

4. Adhere to any rules and policies of a school athletic association which provides the coordination, supervision, and regulation of the extracurricular activities and contests of schools;

5 5. Adhere to any physical exams or drug testing provisions 6 required by the board of education of the resident district or the 7 school athletic association which provides the coordination, 8 supervision, and regulation of the extracurricular activities and 9 contests of schools; and

10 6. Adhere to the same academic standards as other participants 11 of the resident district pursuant to the provisions of subsection D 12 of this section.

13 During the time period a student who is educated by other D. 14 means participates in extracurricular activities pursuant to the 15 provisions of this section, the student shall demonstrate adherence 16 to academic standards by a method of evaluation agreed upon by the 17 parent or legal quardian of the student and the superintendent of 18 the resident district. The method of evaluation may include a 19 review of the student's work by a certified teacher employed by the 20 resident district; the student's performance on a nationally 21 recognized standardized test; or evaluation of grades earned through 22 correspondence courses.

23SECTION 2.AMENDATORY70 O.S. 2021, Section 27-103, is24amended to read as follows:

Section 27-103. A public school or school district shall not be a member of any school athletic association unless that association has adopted a written policy that requires the following:

All records of the association to be made accessible
consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act;

All meetings of the association to be open and conducted in
a manner consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting
Act<sub>r</sub> including specifically the notice and agenda, voting and
executive session requirements; and

10 3. An annual financial audit and a compliance audit of all 11 funds of the association in accordance with the auditing standards 12 set forth in the Oklahoma Public School Audit Law. In addition, the 13 association shall have performance audits conducted of the 14 operations of the association. A performance audit shall be 15 conducted no later than December 31, 2014, and by December 31 every 16 five (5) years thereafter; and

4. That a student who is educated pursuant to the other means
exception provided for in subsection A of Section 10-105 of this
title is allowed to participate in interscholastic activities or
contests offered by the student's resident district as defined in
Section 1-113 of this title. Student participation shall be subject
to the provisions of Section 1 of this act.
SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
