13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 17-116.10,			
15	is amended to read as follows:			
16	Section 17-116.10. A. Subject to the requirements of Section			
17	6-101.2 of this title and any other applicable requirements of law,			
18	a member of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma may enter			
19	into postretirement employment with a public school of Oklahoma and			
20	still receive monthly retirement benefits subject to the following			
21	limitations:			
22	1. A retired member is not eligible to be employed by the			
23	public schools of Oklahoma, in any capacity, for sixty (60) calendar			
24 27	days between the retiree's last day of preretirement public			

1 education employment and any postretirement public education 2 employment. For purposes of this section, the term "last day of 3 preretirement employment" shall mean the last day the employee is 4 required to be physically present on the job to complete the terms 5 of the employment contract or agreement. An employee on paid leave 6 is still considered to be employed for purposes of this section. 7 Employment under any conditions during this time, volunteer services 8 for the purpose of obtaining a paid position at a later date, or 9 payment at a later time for services performed during this time 10 period shall cause the forfeiture of all retirement benefits 11 received during the period;

12 2. Unless otherwise provided in paragraph 3 of this subsection, 13 earnings from the public schools may not exceed one-half (1/2) of 14 the member's final average salary used in computing retirement 15 benefits, or the Earnings Limitation earnings limitation for 16 employees allowed by the Social Security Administration, whichever 17 For retired members under the age of sixty-two (62) years, is less. 18 the limit on allowed earnings from the public schools of Oklahoma 19 for employment for the performance of duties ordinarily performed by 20 classified or nonclassified personnel shall be the lesser of Fifteen 21 Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) or one-half (1/2) of the member's 22 final average salary used in computing retirement benefits unless 23 the earnings limitation allowed by the Social Security 24 Administration would be greater than Fifteen Thousand Dollars _ _

1 (\$15,000.00). For retired members sixty-two (62) years of age or 2 older the limit on allowed earnings from the public schools of 3 Oklahoma for the performance of duties ordinarily performed by 4 classified or nonclassified personnel shall be the lesser of Thirty 5 Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) or one-half (1/2) of the member's 6 final average salary used in computing retirement benefits. On and 7 after the effective date of this act, for retired members under the 8 age of sixty-two (62) years, the limit on allowed earnings from the 9 public schools of Oklahoma for employment for the performance of 10 duties ordinarily performed by classified or nonclassified personnel 11 shall be the lesser of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) or one-12 half (1/2) of the member's final average salary used in computing 13 retirement benefits unless the earnings limitation allowed by the 14 Social Security Administration would be greater than Thirty Thousand 15 Dollars (\$30,000.00). On and after the effective date of this act, 16 for retired members sixty-two (62) years of age or older, the limit 17 on allowed earnings from the public schools of Oklahoma for the 18 performance of duties ordinarily performed by classified or 19 nonclassified personnel shall be the lesser of Fifty-five Thousand 20 Dollars (\$55,000.00) or one-half (1/2) of the member's final average 21 salary used in computing retirement benefits. Notwithstanding paragraph 2 of this subsection, a retired classified or nonclassified member who has been retired for thirtysix (36) or more months and who is employed by a public school to perform duties ordinarily performed by classified or nonclassified personnel shall be able to receive annualized earnings from the

1 public school with no reduction in retirement benefits regardless of 2 the amount of annualized earnings. For a period of three (3) years 3 beginning July 1, 2017, members who have retired as of July 1, 2017, 4 as active classroom teachers, who have been retired and receiving a 5 benefit for at least one (1) year, and who have not been employed by 6 any public school during that one-year period, shall be eligible to 7 be reemployed as an active classroom teacher in common or career 8 tech school districts, with no limitations on earnings. For a 9 period of three (3) years beginning July 1, 2021, members who have 10 retired as of July 1, 2020, who have been retired and receiving a 11 benefit for at least one (1) year, and who have not been employed by 12 any public school during that one-year period, shall be eligible to 13 be reemployed as an active classroom teacher in common or career 14 tech school districts, with no limitations on earnings. The one-15 year period starts with the retiree's last day of preretirement 16 public education employment. Members returning under this section 17 shall not be subject to any earning limitations earnings limitation 18 following the end of the three-year periods described in this 19 paragraph. Members returning under this section shall only be 20 employed pursuant to a temporary contract; and

4. A member shall be considered to be employed by a school
district to perform the duties ordinarily performed by classified or
nonclassified personnel if the member is hired by the school
district in the member's individual capacity to perform the duties

or if the member performs the duties through employment with a proprietorship, partnership, corporation, limited liability company or partnership, or any other business structure that has agreed or contracted to provide the services to the school district.

⁵ B. A public school district that employs a retired member shall
⁶ be required to make contributions to the System for the retired
⁷ member in an amount as required in Section 17-108.1 and in paragraph
⁸ 3 of subsection B of Section 17-116.2 of this title.

9 C. For purposes of this section, postretirement employment of
10 less than one thousand (1,000) hours per year with the Governor, the
11 State Senate, the House of Representatives or the Legislative
12 Service Bureau shall not be considered as postretirement employment
13 with a public school of Oklahoma.

D. The Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement System of
 Oklahoma shall promulgate such rules as are necessary to implement
 the provisions of this section.

E. A member who has entered into postretirement employment with a participating employer of the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma must fully comply with all the provisions of the rules promulgated by the Board of Trustees pursuant to this section in order to continue receiving his or her monthly retirement benefit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
