23 as amended by Section 7, Chapter 270, O.S.L. 2014
24 (59 O.S. Supp. 2017, Sections 1151.2 and 1151.9),
which relate to the Roofing Contractor Registration
Act; modifying definition; adding definitions;
adding certain exemptions; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.2, as
amended by Section 1, Chapter 270, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2017,
Section 1151.2), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1151.2 As used in the Roofing Contractor Registration
2 Act:

3 1. "Advertise" means any written publication, dissemination,
4 solicitation, contract, bid, promotional item, or circulation which
5 is intended to directly or indirectly induce any person to contract
6 for roofing construction services with the advertiser, including,
7 but not limited to, business cards, telephone directory display
8 advertisements, vehicle signage, radio, television and electronic
9 solicitations;

10 2. "Applicant" means the qualifying party, or if no qualifying
11 party, any person applying under the Roofing Contractor Registration
12 Act for a roofing contractor registration to be issued by the
13 Construction Industries Board;

14 3. "Board" means the Construction Industries Board;

15 4. "Committee" means the Committee of Roofing Examiners;

16 5. "Homeowner" means one who owns and resides in, or who
17 resides in, or who contracts for the purchase, construction,
18 remodeling or repairing of a residence;

19 6. "Nonresident contractor" means any contractor who has not
20 established and maintained a place of business as a roofing
21 contractor in this state within the preceding year, or who claims
22 residency in another state, or who has not submitted an income tax
23 return as a resident of this state within the preceding year;

1 7. "Owner" means person who owns the property or is a lessee of
2 the property;

3 8. "Person" means any natural person, firm, limited or general
4 partnership, corporation, association, limited liability company,
5 trust, association, other legal entity and any organization capable
6 of conducting business, or any combination thereof acting as a unit,
7 unless the intent to give a more limited meaning is disclosed
8 clearly by the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

9 9. "Prime contractor" means a general contractor, commercial
10 contractor, or other contractor who contracts directly with the
11 owner for construction trade work in multiple trade areas;

12 10. "Project manager" means one who manages construction
13 projects consisting of work involving multiple trades;

14 11. "Public contract" means a contract with the State of
15 Oklahoma, its political subdivisions, or any board, commission, or
16 department thereof, or with any board of county commissioners, or
17 with any city council, school board, or with any state or municipal
18 agency, or with any other public board, body, commission, or agency
19 authorized to award contracts for the construction or reconstruction
20 of public works and includes subcontracts undertaken to perform
21 works covered by the original contract or any part thereof;

22 12. "Qualifying party" means a natural person who is an officer
23 or owner of the corporation, a member of the limited liability
24 company, or a general partner of the limited liability partnership,

1 and who is actively engaged in the work undertaken by the registrant
2 for which a registration is required pursuant to the Roofing
3 Contractor Registration Act who meets the experience and ability
4 requirements for registration on behalf of the registrant;

5 13. "Registrar" means the Construction Industries Board or any
6 person designated by the Board to administer the provisions of the
7 Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

8 14. "Registration" means the process of applying for an initial
9 or renewal registration which upon approval is exhibited by a
10 registration number and card issued pursuant to the Roofing
11 Contractor Registration Act;

12 15. "Registration number" means the roofing registration number
13 issued by the registrar to the registrant's qualifying party;

14 16. "Registrant" means a holder of a registration issued
15 pursuant to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

16 17. "Residence" means a single structure for residential
17 occupancy or use which is a detached one- to four-family dwelling or
18 a multiple single-family dwelling (townhouse) not more than three
19 stories/floors above grade plane in height with a separate means of
20 egress, and any appurtenances thereto, which is intended for use as
21 a primary habitation and is in compliance with the International

8 wood shakes or other comparable materials to a sloped roof and to
9 complete roofing work; and

8 of the United States Government, the State of Oklahoma, or any
9 county, municipality, or other political subdivision of this state;

10 3. Any person who furnishes any fabricated or finished product,
11 material, or article of merchandise which is not incorporated into
12 or attached to real property by such person so as to become affixed
13 thereto;

14 4. Any person including churches or other charitable entities
15 that provide roof repairs or replacements at no charge using
16 volunteer labor;

17 5. Any employee of a registrant who does not hold himself or
18 herself out for hire, advertise, or engage in contracting, except as
19 an employee of a registrant;

20 6. Licensed engineers, licensed architects, licensed HVAC and
21 any other person licensed by the jurisdiction, operating under the
22 purview and within the scope of their respective license;

23 7. A person who only furnishes roofing materials, roofing
24 supplies or equipment and does not, nor do the person's employees,

1 install or fabricate them into or consume them in the performance of
2 the work of the roofing contractor;

3 8. Prime contractors, general contractors, property managers
4 and project managers who bid on construction trade work in areas
5 additional to roofing contractor work, and subcontract the roofing
6 contractor work as long as they subcontract the roofing work to a
7 currently registered roofing contractor who is in good standing; if
8 the bid is solely for roofing contractor work, then a registration
9 is required;

10 9. Owners of commercial properties including residential rental
11 properties consisting of four dwelling units or less, when acting as
12 their own roofing contractor and providing all material supervision
13 themselves, lessees of residential properties with the consent of
14 the owner, who, whether themselves or with their own employees,
15 perform roofing construction in or upon the properties, all
16 installing roofing materials according to the International Building
17 Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission,
18 or the manufacturer's installation instructions; ~~or~~

19 10. Owners of property when acting as their own roofing
20 contractor, providing all material supervision themselves, and
21 installing roofing materials according to the International
22 Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code
23 Commission, or the manufacturer's installation instructions when
24 building or improving a single-family dwelling residence on such

1 property for the occupancy of such owners and not intended for sale
2 or rent. In any action brought under the Roofing Contractor
3 Registration Act, proof of the sale or offering for sale of such
4 structure or the renting or offering to rent of such structure by
5 the owners of the property within one (1) year after substantial
6 completion of the structure when the structure can be occupied and
7 used as intended but punch list items may remain, is presumptive
8 evidence that the construction was undertaken with the intent of

15 C. Labor-only crews performing the installation of asphalt
16 shingles, tile shingles, synthetic shakes or wood shakes to a sloped
17 roof must be registered but are not required to have a commercial
18 endorsement.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

20 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

8 C. The commercial roofing contractor endorsement shall not
9 apply to metal building erectors who install prefabricated or pre-
10 engineered metal building packages, known as PEMB, as defined by the
11 Construction Science Institute and Construction Specifications
12 Institute in Division 13, Special Construction: Metal Building
13 Systems.

14 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

15 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
