17	Johnson Act".
18	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 173, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 173. A. All persons who, after the commission of any
21	felony, conceal or aid the offender, with knowledge that he or she
22	has committed a felony, and with intent that he the person may avoid
23	or escape from arrest, trial, conviction, or punishment, are
24	accessories.

1	B. In the case of murder, a person is accountable under this
2	section for accessory to murder if the person knew or reasonably
3	should have known that the conduct committed upon the victim could
4	foreseeably result in the death of the victim.
5	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
