6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; amending
8 Section 22, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2016, as amended by
9 Section 6, Chapter 381, O.S.L. 2017 (37A O.S. Supp.
10 2017, Section 2-110), which relates to mixed beverage
11 licenses; modifying acts authorized by license to
12 allow certain sales of beer for off-premises
13 consumption; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 22, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
16 2016, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 381, O.S.L. 2017 (37A O.S.
17 Supp. 2017, Section 2-110), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 2-110. A mixed beverage license shall authorize the
19 holder thereof:

20 1. To purchase alcohol, spirits, beer and/or wine in retail
21 containers from the holder of a wine and spirits wholesaler and beer
22 distributor license as specifically provided by law; ~~and~~

23 2. To sell, offer for sale and possess mixed beverages for on-
24 premises consumption only; provided, the holder of a mixed beverage
license issued for an establishment which is also a restaurant may

1 purchase wine directly from a winemaker and beer directly from a
2 small brewer who is permitted and has elected to self-distribute as
3 provided in Article XXVIII A of the Oklahoma Constitution; and

4 3. In a municipality in which a university is located, to sell
5 beer in original packages only for off-premises consumption, from
6 8:00 a.m. until midnight on the day of any regularly scheduled
7 football game of the university.

8 Sales and service of mixed beverages by holders of mixed
9 beverage licenses shall be limited to the licensed premises of the
10 licensee unless the holder of the mixed beverage license also
11 obtains a caterer license or a mixed beverage/caterer combination
12 license. A mixed beverage license shall only be issued in counties
13 of this state where the sale of alcoholic beverages by the
14 individual drink for on-premises consumption has been authorized. A
15 separate license shall be required for each place of business.

16 Upon application, a mixed beverage license shall be issued for
17 any place of business functioning as a motion picture theater, as
18 defined by Section 1-103 of this title. Provided, that upon proof
19 of legal age to consume alcohol, every patron being served alcoholic
20 beverages shall be required to wear a wrist bracelet or receive a
21 hand stamp identifying the patron as being of legal age to consume
22 alcohol. This requirement shall only apply inside a motion picture
23 theater auditorium where individuals under the legal age to consume
24 alcohol are allowed.
