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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 92, O.S.L.
16	2015, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 45, O.S.L. 2017 (17 O.S.
17	Supp. 2017, Section 160.20), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 160.20. A. After the effective date of this act August
19	21, 2015, no wind energy facility may be constructed if the base of
20	any tower is located at a distance of less than:
21	1. One and one-half (1 $1/2$) nautical miles from the center line
22	of any runway located on:
23	a. a public-use airport as defined in Section 120.2 of
24	Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or

b. an airport owned by a municipality;

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2. One and one-half $(1 \ 1/2)$ nautical miles from any public school which is a part of a public school district; or

- 3. One and one-half $(1 \ 1/2)$ nautical miles from a hospital.
- After the effective date of this act, construction or operation of a proposed wind energy facility or proposed wind energy facility expansion shall not encroach upon or otherwise have a significant adverse impact on the mission, training or operations of any military installation or branch of military. No wind energy facility may be constructed or expanded unless a letter of noninterference is obtained. The Military Strategic Planning Commission shall facilitate the procurement of this letter by coordinating the applicant, the U.S. Department of Defense siting clearinghouse and the local base commanders. The evaluation shall consider whether the proposed wind energy facility or proposed wind energy facility expansion would cause interference with air navigation routes, air traffic control areas, military training routes, radar, drop zones or bombing ranges based on information submitted by the applicant, the U.S. Department of Defense's siting clearinghouse, and the local base commanders. The letter of noninterference shall be filed with the Corporation Commission.
 - $\underline{\text{C.}}$ Attestation of compliance with the setback requirements in this section shall be included in any reports required by the

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Corporation Commission. Disputes arising under this section shall
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    fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of the district courts.
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        SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
