"High deductible health plan" means a high deductible health 2 plan as defined pursuant to Section 7002 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma 3 Statutes. 4 B. Any high deductible health plan that is offered, issued, or 5 renewed on or after the effective date of this act shall not subject 6 prescription drugs used to treat chronic conditions to the annual 7 deductible established by the plan. 8 C. The Insurance Commissioner, in consultation with the 9 Oklahoma Health Care Authority, shall promulgate rules to establish 10 a list of qualifying prescription drugs under subsection B of this 11 section and any other rules necessary to effectuate the provisions 12 of this section. 13 SECTION 2.
