An Act relating to the Office of the Secretary of State; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 661.1, which relates to classification of employees; modifying employees in unclassified service.

SUBJECT: Unclassified service

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 661.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 661.1. Effective July 1, 1982, <u>A. Except as provided</u> in subsection B of this section, all positions of the Office of the Secretary of State, except the Secretary of State, Assistant Secretary of State and one secretary who shall remain in the unclassified service, shall become <u>are</u> subject to the Merit System of Personnel Administration. <u>All incumbent employees shall be</u> classified without the need to pass examinations and shall be allocated in accordance with the recommended classifications as proposed by the Merit System.

B. The following positions of the Office of the Secretary of State shall be in the unclassified service:

1. The Secretary of State;

- 2. The Assistant Secretary of State;
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer;
- 4. The Deputy Assistant of Native American Affairs; and
- 5. One Executive Secretary.
