by the Governor as soon as practical after the applicable election
to fill the unexpired term.

Whenever a vacancy shall occur in any elective county office 3 Β. of any county in this state having a population of more than the 4 5 population figure specified in subsection B E of Section 10 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the vacancy shall be filled at a 6 special election to be called by the Governor within thirty (30) 7 days after the vacancy occurs. Provided, no special election shall 8 9 be called if the vacancy occurs in an even-numbered year if the term 10 of the office expires the following year, or if the vacancy occurs within one hundred twenty (120) days prior to the first day of the 11 12 regular candidate filing period for the office. In such case, the 13 candidate elected to the office at the Primary Election, runoff Primary Election, or the regular General Election shall be appointed 14 by the Governor as soon as practical after the applicable election 15 to fill the unexpired term. 16 17 SECTION 2.
