Except as otherwise provided in the Oklahoma Minimum 21 Wage Act, no employer within the State of Oklahoma employers of this 22 state shall pay any employee employees a wage of not less than 23 Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00) an hour with an increase of fifty cents 24 (\$0.50) per year over a five-year period after the effective date of
