B. Data collected pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be submitted in the aggregate to the State Department of Education, which shall use the data to inform decisions regarding professional development offered to teachers, and to the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability, which shall share the data with teacher education programs.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
