- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 772 of Title 22, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Notwithstanding Sections 761 through 771 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, upon a motion made by a defendant, a court or judge satisfied that good cause exists, shall order the examination of a witness by deposition. The order shall specify the time, place, and form of the examination. A court or judge may prescribe such terms and conditions to the examination as are just.
- B. Upon a mutual agreement between the parties and approval by the court, a deposition of a witness pursuant to subsection A of
