1	be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
2	or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1)
3	year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition to the

6	in an amount equal to three times the value of the damage caused by
7	the accident. Said damages shall be recoverable in a civil action.
