14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-316 of Title 29, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. The Department of Wildlife Conservation shall produce an elk
18	population study to be presented electronically to the Legislature
19	and the Governor on or before a year following the effective date of
20	this act.
21	B. The study shall be used to determine Oklahoma's elk
22	population in southeastern Oklahoma. The study may incorporate
23	information available in other sources, such as studies produced by
24	collegiate or federal resources, into an analysis of Oklahoma's elk

1	population. The Department may also enter into agreements with
2	other agencies, organizations operating in this state, or tribal
3	governments to assist with the production of this study.
4	C. The study may include recommendations by the Department for
5	the conservation of Oklahoma elk populations.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
