6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to energy; creating the Oklahoma  
8 Consumer Energy Choice Act; providing short title;  
9 defining term; prohibiting certain entities from  
10 adopting certain policies that limit consumer access  
11 to certain energy sources; providing for  
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000 of Title 52, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma  
18 Consumer Energy Choice Act".

19 B. For the purposes of this act, "energy source" means any  
20 source used to generate electric power including but not limited to:  
21 aviation fuel, biofuel, compressed natural gas, diesel, electricity  
22 to be utilized for the charging of electric vehicles, gasoline, gas  
23 distillates, hydrogen, liquified petroleum gas, and renewable  
24 diesel.

1 C. No city, town, county, or political subdivision shall adopt  
2 an ordinance, rule, or code which limits consumer access to an  
3 energy source or that results in the de facto prohibition of a  
4 wholesaler, retailer, or the related infrastructure that is  
5 necessary to provide consumer access to a specific energy source  
6 within the jurisdiction of a city, town, or county.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
