7	An Act relating to nuclear energy; directing the
8	Department of Environmental Quality to promulgate rules; defining term; authorizing a certain entity to

11	code; requiring certain entity to submit letter of intent and application to the Department;

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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-501 of Title 27A, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. 1. The Department of Environmental Quality shall promulgate
20	rules for the purpose of creating a regulatory environment for a
21	qualifying entity to construct a nuclear power plant.
22	2. For the purposes of this section, "qualified entity" or
23	"entity" means an entity that has complied with federal and state
24 2 7	requirements for constructing a nuclear power plant and has had its

¹ application approved by the Department pursuant to this section. An
² entity that seeks to construct a nuclear power plant in this state
³ shall be deemed a qualified entity under this section provided that
⁴ the entity follows the regulations and guidance of the federal
⁵ Nuclear Regulatory Commission and is granted the necessary licenses
⁶ under 10 C.F.R. Part 50.

B. An entity seeking to construct a nuclear power plant under
 this section shall also construct a facility within the same 5-digit
 postal code of the proposed plant location with sufficient capacity
 to receive the spent fuel from the plant.

C. An entity seeking to construct a nuclear power plant under this section shall, in a form to be prescribed by the Department, submit a letter of intent to construct the plant and facility and an application for approval of the construction. The application shall include, but not be limited to:

16 1. The projected dates for beginning and completing 17 construction;

18 2. The location of the proposed nuclear power plant and 19 facility;

20 3. Copies of any applications, correspondence, or forms
21 submitted in accordance with the requirements of the federal Nuclear
22 Regulatory Commission;

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1	4. Any statistics or information conveying the cost-
2	effectiveness, efficiency, and energy-saving possibility of the
3	proposed facility; and
4	5. Any other information deemed necessary by the Department for
5	approval.
6	D. The Department shall promulgate any rules necessary to
7	effectuate the provisions of this section.
8	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
