	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-110a of Title 11, unless

L7	A. A territory may be detached from the corporate limits of a
18	municipality when the governing municipality has defunded the police

21	"Defunded" means the municipality has adopted a budget for a
22	fiscal year that reduces appropriated monies to the municipal police
23	department by five percent (5%) or greater compared to the previous

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fiscal year.

1	This provision shall not apply to municipalities that have a
2	total budget that is at least ten percent (10%) less than the
3	previous fiscal year
4	B. A municipality shall not annex an area during a fiscal year
5	that defunds the municipal police department unless the budget of
6	the police department is the same or exceeds what it was before it
7	was defunded.
8	C. Any annexed territory that wishes to detach from the
9	governing municipality shall comply with all procedures in Section
10	21-110 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
