19	cessation of work as a form of protest; and
20	2. "Public employee" shall mean an employee of a state agency,
21	political subdivision, or school district.
22	B. A public employee may not strike or engage in an organized
23	work stoppage against the state, a political subdivision of this
24	state, or any public school district.

A public employee who violates the provisions of subsection 2 B of this section automatically forfeits his or her employment with 3 the state, political subdivision, or public school district, all 4 civil service rights, pensions, reemployment rights, and any other 5 rights, benefits, and privileges the employee enjoys as a result of 6 public employment or former public employment. 7 D. A public employee who is employed as a teacher or 8 administrator and violates subsection B of this section shall have 9 his or her teaching certificate revoked. 10 Ε.
