16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2021, Section 405.4, is						
17	amended to read as follows:						
18	Section 405.4. A. Any person with a bachelor's degree or						
19	postgraduate degree shall be considered as having met the						
20	educational requirements for a director of a full-time child care						
21	center required by the Department of Human Services. Nothing in						
22	this section shall be construed as to affect annual continuing						
23	education requirements. The director of a child care center may						
24	also qualify as a master teacher for children of all ages.

- B. Any The continuing education requirements established by the Department shall be on a two-year cycle.
- C. Subject to the exemptions provided by subsection D of this section, a person replacing a master teacher at a child care center shall be granted a one-year probationary period to fulfill the educational qualifications required by the Department for a master teacher. The Department may extend the probationary period an additional year as long as the person is actively pursuing that goal.
- D. A person shall be exempt from the educational qualifications required by the Department for a master teacher if the person has:
- 1. Not less than two (2) years of full-time experience or the equivalent in the profession of child care or education as determined by the Department; or
- 2. Obtained not less than six (6) credit hours at an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education or at a technology center school in subjects relevant to child care as determined by the Department.
- C. E. Licensed child care facilities opened or expanded before November 1, 2016, shall have thirty-five (35) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants. New construction and existing space not previously licensed for child care after November 1, 2016, shall have forty (40) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants.
