11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.21, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 427.21. A. A medical marijuana business shall not
14	engage in advertising that is deceptive, false or misleading.
15	B. Medical marijuana advertising shall not contain any
16	statement or illustration that:
17	1. Promotes overconsumption;
18	2. Represents that the use of marijuana has curative or
19	therapeutic effects; or
20	3. Depicts a child or other person under legal age to consume
21	marijuana, or includes:
22	a. objects such as toys or cartoon or other characters,
23	which suggest the presence of a child, or any other
24	depiction designed in any manner to be especially

1	appealing to children or other persons under legal age
2	to consume marijuana, or
3	b. any manner or design that would be especially
4	appealing to children or other persons under eighteen
5	(18) years of age.
6	C. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana
7	commercial grower licensees shall be required to post signage in a
8	conspicuous location at each entrance of the site of the commercial
9	grow operation. The following information shall be included on the
LO	required signage:
L1	1. Business name;
12	2. Physical address of the licensed business;
L3	3. Phone number of the licensed business; and
L 4	4. Medical marijuana business license number.
L5	The required signage shall also comply with county regulations
16	and local ordinances related to the real property where the
L7	commercial grow operation is located. Failure to erect the proper
L8	signage in accordance with the provisions of this subsection shall
L9	result in the immediate revocation of the medical marijuana
20	commercial grower license.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
