9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 23 O.S. 2021, Section 61, is
11	amended to read as follows:
12	Section 61. A. For the breach of an obligation not arising
13	from contract, the measure of damages, except where otherwise
14	expressly provided by this chapter, is the amount which will
15	compensate for all detriment proximately caused thereby, whether it
16	could have been anticipated or not.
17	B. In a trial in an action for the breach of an obligation not
18	arising from contract, a party or counsel for a party shall not seek
19	or refer to a specific dollar amount, state a range, or suggest a
20	mathematical formula for the jury to consider with respect to an
21	award for noneconomic damages.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
