14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20-80 of Title 2, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
19	Industrial Poultry Operations Act".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20-81 of Title 2, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	As used in this act:

¹ "Industrial poultry operations" shall mean any animal feeding ² operation, as defined by Section 20-41 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma ³ Statutes, containing more than two hundred forty thousand (240,000) ⁴ laying hens or broilers.

5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20-82 of Title 2, unless there 7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 Α. In order to mitigate the negative effects on air quality, 9 odors, and pollution, industrial poultry operations where laying 10 hens and broilers are confined, shall have a closed ventilation 11 The closed ventilation system shall include a filtration system. 12 system sufficient to mitigate the effects of odor and pollution in 13 the immediate surrounding areas as determined by the Oklahoma 14 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

B. Industry poultry operations shall be limited to only one facility for every twenty (20) acres of land within a single operation in which laying hens or broilers are confined.

C. After the effective date of this act, no industrial poultry operation shall be established within one and one half (1 1/2) miles of any public school.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20-83 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
