SENATE BILL 1760

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to vaccines; requiring health care provider to provide certain information; requiring health care provider to offer alternative vaccine to certain patients; directing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3170 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A health care provider who administers a vaccine in this state shall inform the patient, prior to administration of the vaccine, if the vaccine contains human DNA and shall offer an appropriate alternative vaccine to a patient who refuses the vaccine containing human DNA. The State Commissioner of Health shall promulgate rules to implement and enforce the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
