14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 6004, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 6004. The Tax Commission shall require every person
18	licensed as a dealer in aircraft pursuant to the provisions of
19	Sections 251 through 257 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes to make
20	a report to the Tax Commission within a period of thirty (30) days
21	after the transfer by such person of the legal ownership of any
22	aircraft. The report shall be made on a form prescribed and
23	furnished by the Tax Commission, showing the name and address of the
24	purchaser, a description of the aircraft $_{m au}$ including the name of the

1	manufacturer, the Federal Aviation Administration registration
2	number of the aircraft, the type and year manufactured, the serial
3	number, the date of the transfer, whether the aircraft is exempt
4	from the aircraft excise tax pursuant to Section 6003 of this title,
5	and the amount of the sale price. The Tax Commission may cancel or
6	suspend the license of any person licensed as a dealer in aircraft
7	pursuant to the provisions of Sections 251 through 257 of Title 3 of
8	the Oklahoma Statutes who shall fail or refuse to comply with the
9	provisions of Sections $\frac{2}{6001}$ through $\frac{8}{6007}$ of this act title.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
