6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to nuclear energy; directing  
8 Department of Environmental Quality conduct study on  
9 feasibility and establishment of nuclear facilities;  
10 requiring findings of study be reported to certain  
11 state officials; providing for codification; and  
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-9-111 of Title 27A, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 On or before January 1, 2024, the Department of Environmental  
18 Quality, in coordination with the Office of the Secretary of Energy  
19 and Environment, shall conduct a study pursuant to this section.

20 The study shall focus on the feasibility and establishment of  
21 nuclear facilities located in this state. The study shall also  
22 include the state requirements as specified by United States Nuclear  
23 Regulatory Commission and any method of federal agency approval.

24 The Department shall issue a report based on the findings of the  
study and shall include any recommendations for the establishment of

1 a facility. The report shall be delivered to the Governor, the  
2 Secretary of Energy and Environment, the President Pro Tempore of  
3 the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Chair  
4 of the Senate Energy Committee, and the Chair of the House Energy  
5 and Natural Resources Committee no later than February 1, 2024.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
