13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 10-101, as
15	amended by Section 1, Chapter 214, O.S.L. 2017 (26 O.S. Supp. 2019,
16	Section 10-101), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 10-101. A. The nominees for Presidential Electors of
18	any recognized political party shall be selected at a convention of
19	the party in a manner to be determined by the party.
20	B. The nominees for Presidential Electors shall be certified by
21	the party's chair <u>of the party</u> to the Secretary of the State
22	Election Board no later than July 15 of a presidential election
23	year.

1 C. Failure of a political party to properly certify the names of its nominees for Presidential Electors within the time specified 2 3 shall bar such party from placing any candidates for Presidential Electors on the ballot at the General Election. 4

5 D. 1. A recognized political party shall certify its nominees for President of the United States and Vice President of the United 6 States to the Secretary of the State Election Board no later than 7 seventy-five (75) days prior to the date of the General Election to 8 9 ensure the State Election Board and the county election boards have 10 sufficient time to meet the deadline for sending absentee ballots to uniformed services voters pursuant to federal and state law. 11

12 2. If the nominating convention of a recognized political party is scheduled to conclude after the deadline provided in paragraph 1 13 of this subsection, the Secretary may accept a provisional 14

15 certification of the party's nominees for President and Vice

16 President of the United States. A provisional certification must be received by the Secretary prior to the deadline, and the party shall

provide the official certification of nominees to the Secretary upon 18

the adjournment of the convention. 19

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. 20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 24
