15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-305, as
17	last amended by Section 3, Chapter 44, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp.
18	2019, Section 2-305), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 2-305. A. Except as otherwise provided in this title,
20	at any time after attaining normal retirement date, any member of
21	the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System upon application for
22	unreduced retirement benefits made and approved, may retire, and,
23	during the remainder of the member's lifetime, receive annual
24	retirement pay, payable in equal monthly payments, equal to two and

1 one-half percent (2 1/2%) of the final average salary times years of 2 credited service. If such retired member is reemployed by a state 3 agency in a position which is not covered by the System, such retired member shall continue to receive in-service distributions 4 5 from the System. Prior to September 19, 2002, if such retired 6 member was reemployed by a state agency in a position which is covered by the System, such member shall continue to receive in-7 service distributions from the System and shall not accrue any 8 9 further credited service. If such a member is reemployed by a state 10 agency in a position which is covered by the System on or after 11 September 19, 2002, such member's monthly retirement payments shall 12 be suspended until such member retires and is not reemployed by a state agency in a position which is covered by the System. 13

Beginning July 1, 1994, members who retired or were eligible 14 Β. to retire prior to July 1, 1980, or their surviving spouses shall 15 receive annual retirement pay, payable in equal monthly payments, 16 equal to the greater of their current retirement pay, or two and 17 one-half percent (2 1/2%) of the actual paid gross salary being 18 currently paid to a highway patrol officer, at the time each such 19 monthly retirement payment is made, multiplied by the retired 20 member's years of credited service. 21

C. Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, members of the System whose salary is set by statute who have retired after completion of the mandatory twenty (20) years of service, and those

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1 members with statutory salaries who retire after reaching the 2 mandatory twenty-year retirement, or those members that had to 3 retire due to a service-connected disability and were unable to 4 complete the mandatory twenty-year retirement pursuant to subsection 5 E of this section, shall receive an annual retirement pay, payable in equal monthly installments, based upon the greater of either: 6 The top base salary currently paid to the highest 7 1. nonsupervisory position in the participating agency $_{\mathcal{T}}$ at the time 8 9 each such monthly retirement payment is made, limited to the annual 10 salary limit of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation 11 Act of 2001, as described in paragraph 9 of Section 2-300 of this 12 title, multiplied by two and one-half percent (2 1/2%) multiplied by the number of years of credited service and fraction thereof for the 13 following positions: 14

- 15 a. Oklahoma Highway Patrolman,
- 16 b. Communications Dispatcher,
- 17 c. Capitol Patrolman,
- 18 d. Lake Patrolman, and
- e. Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation Special Agent
 or Criminalist; or

21 2. The member's final average salary as set forth in paragraph 22 9 of Section 2-300 of this title, multiplied by two and one-half 23 percent (2 1/2%), and multiplied by the number of years of credited 24 service and fraction thereof.

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No member of the System retired prior to July 1, 2002, shall
 receive a benefit less than the amount the member is receiving as of
 June 30, 2002.

The provisions of paragraph 1 of this subsection shall not be applicable to any member whose first participating service with the System occurs on or after November 1, 2012.

7 D. Other members of the System whose retirement benefit is not otherwise prescribed by this section who have retired after 8 9 completion of the mandatory twenty (20) years of service, and those 10 members who retire after reaching the mandatory twenty-year retirement, or those members that had to retire due to a service-11 12 connected disability and were unable to complete the mandatory twenty-year retirement pursuant to subsection E of this section, 13 shall receive an annual retirement pay, payable in equal monthly 14 15 payments, based upon the greater of either:

16 1. The actual average salary currently paid to the highest nonsupervisory position in the participating agency τ at the time 17 each such monthly payment is made, limited to the annual salary 18 limit of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 19 2001, as described in paragraph 9 of Section 2-300 of this title, 20 multiplied by two and one-half percent (2 1/2%), multiplied by the 21 number of years of credited service and fraction thereof for the 22 following positions: 23

If the salary of a member is not prescribed by a specific salary schedule 10 11 upon the date of the member's disability, the final 12 average salary for the member shall be computed by the member's actual final average salary or the highest 13 median salary amount for a member whose salary was 14 15 prescribed by a specific salary schedule upon the date of the member's disability, whichever final average 16 salary amount would be greater, or 17

b. the actual final average salary of the member if the
member had performed twenty (20) or more years of
service prior to disability.

If such member participates in the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Deferred Option Plan pursuant to Section 2-305.2 of this title, such member's disability pension provided pursuant to this subsection shall be adjusted as provided in Section 2-305.2 of this title to

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account for such member's participation in the Oklahoma Law
 Enforcement Deferred Option Plan.

3 A member who meets the definition of disability as defined G. in Section 2-300 of this title and whose disability occurred prior 4 5 to the member's normal retirement date but after completing three (3) years of vesting service and not by reason of the performance of 6 the member's duties or as a result of the member's willful 7 negligence shall receive a monthly benefit equal to two and one-half 8 9 percent (2 1/2%) of final average salary multiplied by the number of 10 years of the member's credited service.

H. Payment of a disability pension shall commence as of the first day of the month coinciding or next following the date of retirement and shall continue as long as the member meets the definition of total and permanent disability provided in this section.

I. For the purpose of determining the member's disability under 16 subsection E, F or G of this section, the member shall be required 17 by the Board to be examined by a minimum of two recognized 18 physicians selected by the Board to determine the extent of the 19 member's injury or illness. The examining physicians shall furnish 20 the Board a detailed written report of the injury or illness of the 21 examined member establishing the extent of disability and the 22 possibilities of the disabled member being returned to his or her 23 regular duties or an alternate occupation or service covered by the 24

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1 System after a normal recuperation period. The Board shall require all retired disabled members who have not attained their normal 2 3 retirement date to submit to a physical examination once each year for a minimum of three (3) years following retirement. The Board 4 5 shall select a minimum of two physicians to examine the retired members and pay for their services from the fund. Any retired 6 7 disabled member found no longer disabled by the examining physicians to perform the occupation of the member or an alternate occupation 8 9 or service covered by the System shall be required to return to duty 10 and complete twenty (20) years of service as provided in subsection 11 A of this section, or forfeit all his or her rights and claims under 12 Section 2-300 et seq. of this title.

J. The disability benefit under this section shall be for the lifetime of the member unless such member is found no longer disabled pursuant to subsection I of this section. Such member shall not be entitled to the retirement benefit pursuant to subsection A of this section unless such member returns to active duty and is eligible for a retirement benefit as provided in subsection A of this section.

K. At the postoffer, preemployment physical examination required under paragraph 6 of Section 2-300 of this title, the physician selected by the Board shall determine the extent to which a new member is disabled. If a member is determined to be partially disabled, the physician shall assign a percentage of disability to

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1 such partial disability. If such member then becomes entitled to a disability benefit under either subsection E or subsection G of this 2 3 section, the benefit payable shall be reduced by the percentage which such member was determined to be disabled at the postoffer, 4 5 preemployment physical unless the Board makes a determination that 6 the initially determined percentage of disability at the 7 preemployment physical examination is unrelated to the reason for the disability currently sought pursuant to subsection E or 8 9 subsection G of this section. Upon employment, the member shall 10 disclose to the Board any disability payments received from any 11 source. The amount of disability to be paid to any member cannot 12 exceed one hundred percent (100%) disability from all sources. The provisions of this subsection shall apply only to members whose 13 effective date of membership is on or after July 1, 2000. 14

In addition to the pension provided for under subsection F 15 L. of this section, if said the member has one or more children under 16 the age of eighteen (18) years or under the age of twenty-two (22) 17 years if the child is enrolled full time in and is regularly 18 attending a public or private school or any institution of higher 19 education, Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) a month shall be paid from 20 said the Fund for the support of each surviving child to the member 21 or person having the care and custody of such children until each 22 child reaches the age of eighteen (18) years or reaches the age of 23 twenty-two (22) years if the child is enrolled full time in and is 24

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1 regularly attending a public or private school or any institution of 2 higher education.

3 Notwithstanding any other provisions in Section 2-300 Μ. through 2-315 of this title, in order to be eligible to receive 4 5 disability benefits, a member who meets the definition of disability as defined in paragraph 11 of Section 2-300 of this title shall file 6 7 the member's completed application for disability benefits with the System before such member's date of termination from service and 8 9 provide such additional information that the System's rules require 10 within six (6) months of the System's receipt of such application. If the member's completed application for disability benefits is not 11 12 filed with the System before the member's date of termination from service or such additional information as is required under the 13 System's rules is not provided within six (6) months of the System's 14 15 receipt of such application, such member shall be eligible only for such other benefits as are available to members of the System and 16 shall not be eligible to receive any disability benefits. For good 17 cause shown, the Board of Trustees may waive the requirement that 18 the disability application be filed before the member's date of 19 termination from service. In no event shall a member be eligible to 20 receive any disability benefit if the member's completed application 21 is filed more than six (6) months after the member's date of 22 termination from service. 23

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1 If the requirements of Section 2-305.1C of this title are Ν. 2 satisfied, a member who, by reason of disability or attainment of normal retirement date or age, is separated from service as a public 3 safety officer with the member's participating employer may elect to 4 5 have payment made directly to the provider for qualified health insurance premiums by deduction from his or her monthly disability 6 benefit or monthly retirement payment, after December 31, 2006, in 7 accordance with Section 402(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, 8 as amended. 9

10SECTION 2.AMENDATORY47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-310.2, is11amended to read as follows:

12 Section 2-310.2. Whenever any member of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System currently working in a position 13 identified by paragraph 6 of Section 2-300 of Title 47 of the 14 15 Oklahoma Statutes this title who is enrolled in the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System is unable to perform the member's 16 duties because of sickness or temporary disability caused or 17 sustained while in the discharge of the member's duty as such 18 member, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 840-2.21 of Title 19 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the provisions of Sections 11 and 12 20 of Title 85 Title 85A of the Oklahoma Statutes, the member may be 21 placed on administrative leave with pay by the employing agency for 22 a period of ninety (90) days with the employing agency having the 23 option of extending the leave period for up to an additional ninety 24

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1	(90) days, not to exceed a total of one hundred eighty (180) days.
2	The member's salary and benefits shall continue to be paid by the
3	employing agency without any decrease or disruption of $\frac{1}{1}$
4	salary and benefits. If the recovery period is longer than one
5	hundred eighty (180) days, the member shall use sick leave, annual
6	leave or other authorized leave. Should a member receiving a salary
7	under this section be eligible to receive and should the salary of
8	the member under this section exceed any temporary disability
9	benefit paid to the member under Section 1 et seq. of Title $\frac{85}{85A}$
10	of the Oklahoma Statutes, the member shall transfer such temporary
11	disability benefits under Section 1 et seq. of Title $\frac{85}{85A}$ of the
12	Oklahoma Statutes to the employing agency while the member is sick
13	or temporarily disabled.
