6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; prohibiting the
8 installation of car kill switches; defining term;
9 providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9301 of Title 74, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Legislature, a state entity, or political subdivision
17 shall not enact any law, rule, or ordinance to require any vehicle
18 to install a car kill switch in this state.

19 B. As used in this section, "car kill switch" means any of the
20 following:

- 21 1. Fuel line shutoff valves;
- 22 2. Car battery disconnect switches;
- 23 3. Remote control car battery switches;
- 24 4. Fuse box kill switches; or
- 25

1 5. Ignition wire kill switches.

2 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
