AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1948, as amended by Section 40, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp. 2019, 16 17 Section 1948), is amended to read as follows: Section 1948. All licensed behavioral practitioners licensed 18 pursuant to the Licensed Behavioral Practitioner Act shall be 19 required to satisfactorily complete ten (10) hours of continuing 20 education credits annually. The State Board of Behavioral Health 21 Licensure shall provide forms and require verification of such 22 credits. Such credits shall be earned from courses on empirically 23 validated procedures, taught by instructors certified by the North 24

3	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
