7	An Act relating to vagrancy; amending 11 O.S. 2021,
8	Section 22-123, which relates to vagrancy; defining term; granting businesses certain right; providing
9	for removal of vagrants within certain distance of businesses; providing for codification; and providing
10	an effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2021, Section 22-123, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 22-123. A. As used in this act, "vagrant" means a
16	person who is in, remains in, or wanders about a public or private
17	place for any of the following purposes:
18	1. Gambling with cards, dice, or other gambling paraphernalia;
19	2. Engaging in prostitution, soliciting prostitution, or
20	soliciting for an act of lewdness;
21	3. Engaging in theft or breaking and entering into any
22	building, property, or automobile of another;
23	4. Injuring, destroying, molesting, or defacing any property of
24	another;

1	5. Begging or soliciting alms, provided that such begging or
2	solicitation is not for a bona fide religious, charitable, or
3	eleemosynary organization with the authorization of such
4	organization; or
5	6. Selling, purchasing, trading, or otherwise exchanging,
6	procuring, or making available illegal drugs or contraband.
7	<u>B.</u> The municipal governing body may provide by ordinance for
8	the arrest, fine, and imprisonment of vagrants.
9	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-123.1 of Title 11, unless
11	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
12	A. The proprietor or manager of any business has the right to
13	contact law enforcement to remove a vagrant if such vagrant is
14	within twelve (12) feet of any doorway of a retail or business
15	establishment, even if such vagrant is on public property.
16	B. Law enforcement officers, upon arrival, shall determine
17	whether the person accused of being a vagrant meets the definition
18	established in Section 22-123 of this title, through personal
19	observation or viewing of video footage. Upon determination that
20	such individual meets the definition of a vagrant, the officers
21	shall remove the vagrant to public property that is at least one-
22	half (1/2) mile away from the location of the business which made
23	the initial complaint. Such location for removal shall not be

1	within one-quarter (1/4) mile of a business, to prevent such vagrant
2	from approaching another business.
3	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
