13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Provision NO. 3, State Question
15	781, Initiative Petition NO. 405 (57 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 632),
16	is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 632. <u>A.</u> No later than July 31 of the year following
18	the effective date of this act July 1, 2017, and no later than July
19	31 every year thereafter, the Office of Management and Enterprise
20	Services shall calculate the savings and averted costs that accrued
21	to the state from the implementation of the Oklahoma Smart Justice
22	Reform Act. In making the calculation required by this section, the
23	Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall use actual data
24	or best available estimates where actual data is not available. The

1	calculation shall be final and shall not be adjusted for any
2	subsequent changes in the underlying data.
3	B. No later than August 31 of each year, the Office of
4	Management and Enterprise Services shall provide a copy of the
5	calculation documentation and findings to the President Pro Tempore
6	of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
7	Appropriations Committee Chair of the Senate and the Appropriations
8	and Budget Committee Chair of the House of Representatives.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
