13 relates to alcohol and drug treatment centers;  
14 removing references to certain facilities; repealing  
15 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-106, as amended by Section  
16 148, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (43A O.S. Supp. 2020,  
17 Section 3-106), which relates to the Bill Willis  
18 Community Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
19 Center; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-101, is  
23 amended to read as follows:

24 Section 3-101. The facilities within the Department of Mental  
Health and Substance Abuse Services, which may be maintained for  
residents of the state, are:

1. Griffin Memorial Hospital, Norman;
2. Oklahoma Forensic Center, Vinita;
3. Children's Recovery Center of Oklahoma, Norman;
4. Tulsa Center for Behavioral Health, Tulsa;

- 1 5. Carl Albert Community Mental Health Center, McAlester;
- 2 6. Jim Taliaferro Community Mental Health Center, Lawton;
- 3 7. Central Oklahoma Community Mental Health Center, Norman;
- 4 8. ~~Bill Willis Community Mental Health and Substance Abuse~~
- 5 ~~Services Center, Tahlequah;~~
- 6 ~~9.~~ Northwest Center for Behavioral Health, Woodward;
- 7 ~~10.~~ 9. Oklahoma County Crisis Intervention Center, Oklahoma
- 8 City;
- 9 10. Oklahoma Crisis Recovery Unit, Oklahoma City; and
- 10 11. ~~Norman Alcohol and Drug Treatment Center, Norman; and~~

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-107, as  
13 amended by Section 149, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (43A O.S. Supp.  
14 2020, Section 3-107), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 3-107. A. There ~~are~~ is hereby created and designated  
16 as ~~facilities~~ a facility within the Department of Mental Health and  
17 Substance Abuse Services, ~~the Norman Alcohol and Drug Treatment~~  
18 ~~Center at Norman and~~ the Rose Rock Recovery Center at Vinita. The  
19 ~~facilities~~ facility shall be operated under the supervision and  
20 administration of the Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance  
21 Abuse Services. It is the intent of the Legislature that the  
22 ~~centers in Norman and~~ Rose Rock Recovery Center at Vinita utilize  
23 and receive business management, support services and medical  
24

1 ancillary services of the ~~respective state facility where the center~~  
2 ~~is located~~ Oklahoma Forensic Center.

3 B. There ~~are~~ is hereby created ~~separate a~~ petty cash ~~funds for~~  
4 ~~the Alcohol and Drug Treatment Centers at Norman and~~ fund for the  
5 Rose Rock Recovery Center at Vinita. The Director of the Office of  
6 Management and Enterprise Services and the Commissioner of Mental  
7 Health and Substance Abuse Services are authorized to fix the  
8 maximum amount of ~~each~~ the petty cash fund. The Director of the  
9 Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall prescribe the  
10 rules and procedures for the administration of ~~each~~ the petty cash  
11 fund.

12 C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
13 is authorized to effect the transfer of property, records,  
14 equipment, supplies, funds, ~~and encumbrances from Griffin Memorial~~  
15 ~~Hospital to or from the Norman Alcohol and Drug Treatment Center;~~  
16 ~~and to effect the transfer of property, records, equipment,~~  
17 ~~supplies, funds, and encumbrances from the Oklahoma Forensic Center~~  
18 to or from the Rose Rock Recovery Center at Vinita.

19 SECTION 3. REPEALER 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-106, as  
20 amended by Section 148, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (43A O.S. Supp.  
21 2020, Section 3-106), is hereby repealed.

22 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
