16	section and Sections 11-103.13 and 11-103.14 of this title shall be
17	known and may be cited as the "Health Education Act".
18	B. The purpose of this act the Health Education Act is to:
19	1. Ensure students receive instruction in health, particularly
20	at an early age when habits are formed;
21	2. Support the health and well-being of children that have been
22	affected by traumatic experiences;
23	3. Improve academic outcomes for students; and

2	population.
3	C. Students shall receive instruction only in the subject areas
4	of physical fitness, nutrition, substance use and abuse prevention,
5	and injury prevention and personal health.
6	$\overline{ ext{D.}}$ The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to
7	implement the provisions of this act the Health Education Act.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
9	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
