16	A. It shall be unlawful for any federal or state agency, any
17	political subdivision, or any business under contract with a federal
18	or state agency or political subdivision to:
19	1. Require any resident of this state to wear a mask or face
20	covering; or
21	2. Discriminate against any resident of this state due to such
22	resident's refusal to wear a mask or face covering.
23	B. This section shall not apply to:
24	1. Public or private health care or long-term care settings;

1	2. Law enforcement officers, firefighters, emergency medical
2	personnel, or emergency response personnel; or
3	3. Service members of the United States Armed Forces.
4	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
