7	An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
8	Section 5-106, which relates to superintendent contracts; updating statutory language; requiring
9	certain boards of education to issue a request for proposals prior to entering into certain contract;
10	requiring a board to publicly disclose certain names prior to entering into certain written contract;
11	updating statutory reference; removing certain limitation on superintendent simultaneously serving
12	in certain role; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 5-106, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 5-106. A. The governing board of each school district
18	in Oklahoma <u>this state</u> is hereby designated and shall hereafter be
19	known as the board of education of such district. Except as
20	otherwise provided in this section, the superintendent of schools
21	appointed and employed by the board shall be the executive officer
22	of the board and shall perform duties as the board directs.
23	B. The board of education of a school district that chooses to
24 27	use the superintendent search services of an organization or vendor

¹ shall issue a request for proposals prior to entering into a
² contract for such services.

C. Prior to entering into a written contract with a superintendent, the board shall publicly disclose the names of the final three candidates being considered for the position. If the final number of candidates is fewer than three, the board shall publicly disclose the names of the candidate(s).

<u>D.</u> The board may contract with a superintendent for a term as mutually agreed upon but not to exceed three (3) years beyond the fiscal year in which the contract is approved by the board and accepted by the superintendent. The contract shall include all other terms and conditions as agreed upon in writing by the board and the superintendent.

14 C. E. The boards of two or more school districts may contract
 15 with one superintendent to serve as superintendent of the school
 16 districts as provided in Section 4 Section 5-106A of this act title.

¹⁷ Đ. <u>F.</u> No board of a school district having average daily ¹⁸ membership (ADM) of fewer than five hundred (500) pupils shall be ¹⁹ prohibited from allowing a superintendent to serve simultaneously as ²⁰ a principal.

E. G. The chief executive officer of the board of education of a district in which a public developmental research school is established shall be the director of the school appointed as provided in Section 1210.577 of this title.

3	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
4	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
