6	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Children's Code; amending 10A O.S. 2011, Section 1-4-602, which
7	relates to petitions for adjudication; requiring Department of Human Services to make certain
8	amendments to internal documents; prohibiting use of certain allegations against parent in future
9	proceedings; providing for retroactive applicability; and providing an effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10A O.S. 2011, Section 1-4-602, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1-4-602. If the court finds that the factual
16	allegations of the petition are not supported by a preponderance of
17	the evidence, the court shall order the petition dismissed and shall
18	order the child discharged from any custody. The child's parents,
19	guardian or other legal custodian shall also be discharged from any
20	restriction or other previous temporary order. <u>Upon the dismissal</u>
21	of the petition, the Department of Human Services shall make
22	necessary amendments in its internal documents to reflect that any
23	allegations that may have been substantiated were determined by the
24	court to not be supported by a preponderance of the evidence and

1	that the petition was dismissed. Any substantiated allegations that
2	were part of a petition which was dismissed shall not be used
3	against the parent in any future court proceeding and shall be
4	treated by the Department as if the allegations were
5	unsubstantiated. This section shall be retroactive and shall apply
6	regardless of when the allegations were substantiated.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
