- A. Upon the effective date of this act, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall not issue any permit for the unnatural transfer of groundwater or surface water originating in or flowing through any portion of water within McCurtain County or issue any permit for groundwater or surface water outside of McCurtain County which would affect the natural amount and flow of waters originating in or flowing through McCurtain County.
- B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not affect any permit, issued by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, in effect prior to the effective date of this act nor shall it affect any current or future permit applications brought before the Board from a local governmental entity for the purpose of providing drinking water for residents of southeastern Oklahoma or by any industry requiring a water permit to construct or operate its business within the region.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
