17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 34.6, as
18	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 342, O.S.L. 2013 (62 O.S. Supp.
19	2019, Section 34.6), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 34.6. A. The Director of the Office of Management and
21	Enterprise Services shall have the power and duty under the
22	direction of the Governor to:
23	1. Prepare the budget document and assist in the drafting of
24	legislation to make it effective;

1 2. Make field surveys and studies of governmental agencies, 2 looking toward economy and greater efficiency; 3 3. Make allotments to control expenditures; 4. Authorize transfers of appropriation authorized by law; 4 5 5. Study accounting and other reports rendered by the Central Accounting and Reporting Division; 6 7 6. Enter into agreements with the United States Secretary of the Treasury for the purpose of implementing federal law; 8 9 7. Aid the Governor in the economical management of state 10 affairs; and 8. Adopt such rules and regulations concerning the exercise of 11 12 powers and duties as the Director shall deem appropriate, in 13 accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.
