13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2021, Section 4-121, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 4-121. A. Except as otherwise provided in this title
16	or in the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act, no person may breed or raise
17	wildlife for personal consumption or noncommercial purposes without
18	having first procured a license from the Director.
19	B. Licenses may be issued to any person that lawfully obtains
20	wildlife, acts in good faith and adheres to the laws of the State of
21	Oklahoma.
22	C. All licenses issued pursuant to this section shall expire on
23	June 30 of each year.

1	D. A license shall not be required by individuals breeding or
2	raising quail for personal consumption or noncommercial purposes,
3	which may include for hobby, education or scientific purposes, or
4	release on private property.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
