9	An Act relating to agriculture; authorizing advertisement of certain products; amending 2 O.S.
10	2021, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act; adding donkey milk to
11	certain exceptions; modifying construing provisions; providing for codification; and providing an
12	effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-422 of Title 2, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	Any person who engages in the on-farm sale of donkey milk may
20	advertise such donkey milk.
21	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, is
22	amended to read as follows:
23	Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk
24	Products Act shall not be construed to:

1	1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers
2	at the farm where the milk is produced; or
3	2. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat milk
4	or donkey milk; and
5	3. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
6	milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.
7	B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
8	or donkey milk are those sales where the average monthly number of
9	gallons sold does not exceed one hundred (100).
10	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
11
