AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to virtual charter schools; requiring each virtual charter school to create and administer certain inventory system; requiring inventory system to include certain items; requiring the inventory system to include the names and grade levels of students provided certain items; requiring certain items to be returned to the virtual charter school upon certain event; requiring the parent or legal quardian of a student to be responsible for the cost of certain unreturned items; requiring a copy of certain inventory system to be submitted to the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board by certain date; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-145.9 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- It shall be the duty of each virtual charter school approved and sponsored by the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-145.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes to create and administer an inventory system for all

Req. No. 344 Page 1 educational supplies paid for by state-appropriated funds, including
but not limited to:

1. Textbooks;

- 2. Electronic textbooks;
- Desktop computers;
 - 4. Laptop computers;
 - 5. Electronic tablets;
 - 6. Printers; and
 - 7. Multimedia materials.
- B. 1. The inventory system shall include the name and grade level of any student to whom items listed in subsection A of this section have been provided.
- 2. A student to whom items listed in subsection A of this section have been provided shall return the items to the virtual charter school prior to graduating from the virtual charter school or transferring to another virtual charter school, a public charter school or a public school district.
- 3. If items provided to a student are not returned to the virtual charter school as required in this subsection, the parent or legal guardian shall be responsible for the cost of such items and shall remit payment to the virtual charter school.
- C. Each virtual charter school shall submit a copy of the inventory system required by this section to the Statewide Virtual
