- 2. Receive any benefits pursuant to the Oklahoma Employees
  Insurance and Benefits Act other than those allowed in connection
  with service as a member of the Legislature; or
- 3. Receive any other benefits other than the compensation directly attributable to his or her employment as provided for in this section, which shall not exceed the compensation paid to persons who are not members of the Legislature who are providing equivalent or substantially similar services.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective upon certification of election returns favoring passage of the Constitutional Amendment proposed in Senate Joint Resolution No. 1 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature.
